### **PUBLIC SPEAKING**

To receive and hear any person who wishes to address the Committee. The Chairman of the Committee will select the order of the matters to be heard. Each speaker will be limited to a period of three minutes (to a maximum of 15 minutes total Public Speaking at the Chairman's discretion)

### **MATTERS FOR DECISION**

- 1. To receive apologies for absence.**
- 2. To receive councillors' declarations of interests.**
- 3. To confirm the minutes of the meeting held on 25 January 2010.**
- 4. In the event that the Committee wishes to consider an agenda item in exempt session, the following resolution should be passed:**

“That the press and public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the following items of business (state agenda item(s)) on the ground that their consideration will involve the disclosure of exempt information as defined in the Local Government Act 1972.”

**5. To consider purchasing 20 chairs for Hangstones pavilion at a cost of up to £500.**

On a number of occasions the number of chairs for the public has been inadequate. (£150 in Seats (201/4045) and £350 could be vired from Property Maintenance (201/4036).)

**6. To consider authorising electrical repairs at Hangstones.**

The electrical test last year resulted in a number of recommendations for repairs. The total cost would be around £400 (Property Maintenance (201/4036))

**7. Further to consider safety surfacing at Hangstones and Broadcroft play areas.**

**8. To consider the purchase of a portable hearing loop.**

Members of the public with hearing difficulties have complained. The Disability Discrimination Act 1995 requires local authorities to make reasonable provision for people with disabilities, including hearing difficulties. Cost around £200, Small Tools & Equipment (201/4040).

**9. To consider the purchase of a grass harrow.**

Cost around £250 (Grounds Maintenance (211/4037)).

**10. Further to consider the purchase of dog bins.**

Suggest one on Stowey Road by footpath 21/3 and one on the footpath behind Binhay Road (resident's suggestion). A bin costs around £60 (vired from Health & Safety, 252/4017) + £1 a week to empty it (252/4035)..
