PUBLIC SPEAKING

To receive and hear any person who wishes to address the Committee. The Chairman of the Committee will select the order of the matters to be heard. Each speaker will be limited to a period of three minutes (to a maximum of 15 minutes total Public Speaking at the Chairman's discretion)

- 1. To receive apologies for absence.**

4. In the event that the Committee wishes to consider an agenda item in exempt session, the following resolution should be passed:

“That the press and public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the following items of business (state agenda item(s)) on the ground that their consideration will involve the disclosure of exempt information as defined in the Local Government Act 1972.”

5. Further to consider the purchase of a portable hearing loop.

Minute AAP324 refers. It now appears that the cost of a loop system adequate for meetings in Hangstones pavilion will be around £1200.

6. To consider the purchase of an aerator

Cost £750 + VAT (Grounds Maintenance (211/4037)).

7. To consider a request from Yatton Junior Football Club to reimburse the Club for the cost of removing the roots of the tree in Rock Road car park.

Cost £350 + VAT. The Club did not inform the Parish Council prior to the work being carried out.

8. To consider allowing an extension to the garage leased to Yeo Valley Lions Club.

Plans will be available at the meeting. The Club will pay the cost of the planning application and (if planning permission is granted) the costs of varying the existing lease.

9. To consider a request from North Somerset Council to locate a recycling bank at Hangstones.

The Co-op is considering asking North Somerset Council to remove the recycling bank from its car park.

10. To consider a request from a resident to move the dog bin at the corner of Chescombe Road and Binhay Road.

This request follows an incident.

11. To consider a proposal to move the playpod currently on Hangstones field to Claverham.

The police have suggested this so that the playpod can house their mobile skatepark. There will be new play facilities on Hangstones field as part of the Playbuilder project.

12. Further to consider the construction of a path on Hangstones field.

The Clerk will report all quotes received to date.
