9. To consider contributing to the cost of a cricket wicket on Hangstones field.

Total cost £7200 + VAT. Claverham Cricket Club have obtained a grant of £3000 from the Lords Taveners towards the cost. (No current budgetary provision but could be met from 299/4935, Hangstones capital projects)

10. To consider management of the land at the corner of Cherry Grove and High Street, Yatton.

If the Council continues to permit cars to be parked on the land it will be subject to business rates (around £400).

11. To consider management of the memorial garden at the burial ground.

The Parish Council has received complaints about the state of the garden.

12. To consider the purchase of a new litter bin for Rock Road car park.

One litter bin has gone missing and the remaining one is too small. Cost £237.28 + VAT (212/4045, Rock Road bins)

13. To consider constructing a concrete ramp up to the container.

Cost £260. (211/4037, Hangstones grounds maintenance)

14. Further to consider ball stop netting at Hangstones.

A local contractor has quoted £900 for raising the height by 1.5 metres.
(211/4017, Hangstones health & safety)

15. To consider a replacement plaque for Yatton Library.

Unfortunate there was a spelling mistake on the recently made plaque. Cost
£229 + carriage + VAT. (252/4045, open spaces signs)

16. To consider a review of signage at the Council's properties.
