Detached youth workers, funded through Quartet walk the streets of Yatton and Claverham with soft drinks and snacks every Wednesday evening, meeting young people who aren’t engaged in any youth provision in the area. Lots of great conversations happen including sign posting to groups, clubs, further education or jobs.



Junior Youth Club – Tuesdays & Thursday 6-7.30pm

Junior youth club sees a regular 20+ young people on a Tuesday and a staggering 63 regulars on a Thursday, it is an amazing atmosphere and the Youth Club put on lots of activities in house so there is something for everyone.



Senior Youth Club

Tuesday’s, Thursday’s & Friday’s 7.30-9pm

Running 3 times a week, we have both new and old faces that mingle well, these sessions are a lot less structured, listening to what the young people want but still including regular trips and in-house activities and chat, mainly focusing around food!
