

VILLAGE MARKETS IN YATTON AND CLAVERHAM

Two village markets are held in the parish each month selling a good selection of local produce and handicrafts – one in Claverham and one in Yatton.

Local produce for sale includes eggs and meat, vegetables and fruit, cheese, homemade preserves and honey, and bread and cakes. A wide selection of plants and flowers in season is usually available, as well as handmade greetings cards and jewellery, plus hand-carved items made from local wood.

Both markets have a welcoming community feel and include indoor facilities for tea and coffee supplied by local residents and community groups.

The markets are held in their respective local village halls from 10-12 noon.

Yatton Village Market is usually held on the second Saturday of each month and Claverham Village Market is on the third Saturday.
