
Bike marking

We expect many of you will have seen them on the roads in larger cities which are piloting a scheme and the rules that when hiring these a driving license is needed to hire them and insurance is covered under the rental full details about these pilot schemes can be found on

We have had a look on some online retail outlets and there is very little info about the law and some of them have links to look at with regards to the law and we understand that some people don't read the small print so we thought it would be good for a timely reminder about the law:

<u>Legal Warning –E scooter law-not to be used on public roads, cycle paths or pavements. Only on private land with the landowners consent.</u>
