8. Street Weed Kill 2019

The Parish Council funded one of the two street weed kills carried out in 2018. To consider providing for this in 2019 the cost will be £500.

9. To consider quotes for emptying parish dog bins discuss providing an additional dog bin at Arnolds Way/North End.
